During the 50 Years at the Village celebration event, vow renewals will take place in the historic 1887 Church. Registered couples will receive a reserved 15-minute ceremony window and a commemorative ceremony certificate. After submitting the registration form, a staff member will contact you to confirm your participation and provide a secure payment link. The suggested minimum donation is \$50 tax-deductible donation, with the option to contribute more to support Manatee Village Historical Park. Please note that additional donations do not affect ceremony time preferences, as scheduling is based on availability and registration order.

Rules and Regulations

The buildings that comprise our museum campus are historical, some over 150 years old, and require special care. Help us preserve them for future generations. Please initial next to each line item to indicate that you understand that any violation of MVHP rules and regulations will result in immediate removal from the property. Registrations will not be accepted unless every line is initialed.

- _____ Smoking is not permitted on the museum campus, including the restrooms and parking lot. Smokers can stand outside of the gate on the 15th Street East sidewalk
- _____ Alcoholic beverages are not allowed on Manatee Village grounds, including the restrooms and parking lot.
- _____ Food or drinks are not permitted in the buildings, with the exception of bottled water.
- _____ Pets are not allowed in any of the buildings, with the exception of service animals. Pets must remain leashed at all times. Guests must clean up after their pets.
- _____ Open flames (including unity candles), grills or pyrotechnics, including sparklers, are not permitted on museum grounds.
- _____ Time Acknowledgment: I understand we should arrive at least 15 minutes before our scheduled ceremony window. I understand that we only have exclusivity of the church during our 15 minute window. If our time runs over, we will be asked to leave.
- _____ Preferred time slots are not guaranteed and are assigned in the order registration is received.
- _____ Manatee Village Historical Park will only provide the space and a commemorative certificate. Couples are responsible for organizing all other aspects.
- _____ Couples are responsible for booking their own professional photographer or assigning someone to take photos during the ceremony. All photographers must complete a form with Manatee Village Historical Park and cannot use the photographs for advertising purposes.
- _____ Decorating is not permitted. Tents, canopies, etc. are not allowed on MVHP grounds.
- _____ Vehicles are not allowed to be driven anywhere on property, except for the parking lot. Parking on 15th Street East for unloading/loading at side gates is not permitted.
- _____ MVHP assumes no responsibility for loss, theft, or damage to equipment. Manatee County Historical Commission and MVHP are not responsible for equipment or personal items left. After 30 days, items left behind may be disposed of.
- _____ With the exception of a bouquet, fresh flowers and live plants are not permitted in the buildings due to the risk of pest infestation.
- _____ No standing on the pews or other furnishings.
- _____ Do not move furniture and equipment, such as the piano, organ, pulpit, bible, flags, and stanchions.
- _____ Amplified music is only allowed inside the church. A Bluetooth speaker is available for use ONLY during you allotted vow renewal time slot.
- _____ Applicants are responsible for cleanup of any facility used and for the cost of repairs for any damage that may occur as a result of their activities. All garbage must be disposed of in the proper containers. Do not climb on outdoor exhibits, trees, etc. and do not handle objects or artifacts in the buildings or on grounds. Children must be closely supervised by an adult at all times. The security deposit will not be returned, and additional fees may be charged, depending on the cost of repairs.
- _____ The minimum donation of \$50 (non-refundable) must be paid within two (2) weeks from the date the secure payment link is sent. Failure to pay within the two (2) week time frame will forfeit your time slot to the next couple in line. Registration fees and any additional donations are non-refundable. Couples that need to cancel after completing registration should notify staff as soon as possible so that scheduling can be adjusted.

*You will be notified in writing when your registration is accepted. Registrations must be received by **June 22nd** to be considered for the 50 Years at the Village Vow Renewal ceremonies. The minimum donation of \$50 must be paid within two (2) weeks from the date the secure payment link was sent. Failure to pay within the two (2) week time frame will forfeit your time slot to the next couple in line. Donations for registration are non-refundable. Should a couple need to cancel, they can choose to cover the cost of another couples booking or leave the donation as is.*
