## **Field Trip FAQs/Points to Note:**

- **Our buildings are not air conditioned except the Wiggins Store.** We suggest wearing close-toed shoes. Please plan accordingly!
- **Staff will greet your group and give a short introduction when you arrive.** We will point out the picnic area and restrooms and will explain why it is important not to touch collection objects and to stay with adults/groups assigned.
- Food and drinks are not permitted in the buildings (except for bottled water). **Our shaded courtyard includes 10 picnic tables that can be used for lunch.**
  - Lunches can either be stored in the cars/buses/vans or in coolers/wagons near the picnic area.
- The Junior Junction playground can be used during your visit at your discretion. The playground is designed for children aged 2-12, and adult supervision is required.
- There are plenty of parking spaces on site including 2 bus spaces. Please use the entrance off 14<sup>th</sup> St. E
- Our gift shop is in the Wiggins Store, but we ask that you limit students in the shop to 10 at a time with adult supervision.
- Due to the historic nature of our buildings, we ask that **groups larger than 15 are split into smaller groups.** This way each group can safely and enjoyably **visit the buildings and exhibits around the site**, including the exhibitions in the Wiggins Store.
- **Restrooms are available on site in the small white building behind the 1887 Church near the picnic pavilion.** Single stall restrooms are available in the Wiggins Store. We recommend that large groups use the restrooms near the pavilion. **A water fountain is available in the Wiggins store and the pavilion near the restrooms.** There are no vending machines or options to buy food/water on site.
