

### **Donation Dip Jar**

Manatee Village Historical Park no longer has the two donation Dip Jars available in the Wiggins Store for credit/debit card donations.

Some of you may be wondering why the Dip Jars are no longer available. In order to use the Dip Jar service Manatee Village Historical Park was required to pay an annual fee. It was discovered that the annual fee was higher than the amount of credit/debit card donations being received. As a result, the Manatee County Historical Commission voted to stop using the Dip Jar service.

### How can visitors donate money to Manatee Village Historical Park?

#### 1. Cash

Cash can be dropped off in the glass donation jar on the Wiggins Store counter or in the donation box located next to the Gift Shop.

### **History Day Judges Needed for Virtual Competition**


